After Marching Band finishes the State Championship, we will transition into different projects to finish the semester for your grade. Note - attendance is REQUIRED and will be taken until the end of the semester for your marching band class grade. ONLY sign up for Jazz, Steel Drum, or Guard if you intend on auditioning into these groups later. Otherwise pick the "Concert Band" option. **PLEASE NOTE: People do NOT need to be in Marching Band to be in Jazz, Steel Drum, or Winter Guard.**

CONCERT BANDS (not interested in Jazz, Steel, or Winter Guard): Dec 6, 10, 11, 12 (6:23-7:15am)

JAZZ BANDS

We will start our jazz groups split up by "new" members and "returning" members (some days, we will all rehearse together as shown). We will play a set of Holiday-themed jazz music for the December 12 Holiday Band Concert Dinner (the dinner will happen at about 5 pm in the Cafeteria prior to the concert). The number of groups is determined by the number of people interested/auditioning into the groups. Last year, we had 3 jazz bands (Jazz Band 1 was the most experienced group). There will be auditions for placement (part, group) but no one is cut from the program who is interested. Wind players have to also be enrolled in a concert band class to audition. Rhythm section players can audition even if they are not part of a concert band or percussion class. Once members audition, we will transition to an "every day" 0 hour rehearsal schedule in January for all jazz groups (you will receive class credit for the Jazz Band class).

STEEL BAND (WORLD MUSIC)

We will start our Steel Band split up by "new" members and "returning" members. Members will receive audition music and be instructed in the basics of the steel drum. No experience is necessary – however, spots are competitive for the group and there are limited spots. Students who are the most prepared for the audition will be selected for the group. Past attendance (tardiness, absences) in marching band, steel band last year, and concert bands/percussion class will also be a determining factor in the audition process. Students that make the band will then start rehearsing for the Fiesta Bowl Parade during Winter Break, then transition to an "every day" 0 hour rehearsal schedule and receive class credit for the world music class. Students are required to be concurrently enrolled in a percussion class or concert band class.

The group will then rehearse consistently during the winter and early spring, performing in several competitive events including a Regional Championship in Las Vegas.
