

Corona del Sol Band & Percussion Year-End Concert!

Tuesday, May 11, 2021

(4th Quarter Project: 1000 points)



Details:

- **This is our big project for Quarter 4** (1000 points in the gradebook). Online and In-Person students will attend to perform in this concert together in person.
- **Masks are required at all times for spectators and performers** (masks must fully cover the mouth AND nose). Wind performers will remove masks ONLY when in assigned seats and playing.
- **This is a FREE concert, but donations are encouraged to help the program survive into the future!**
- **Each Performer will be allowed four (4) guests to watch the concert in the stadium.** Spectators can start lining up outside the stadium no sooner than 6 pm; Spectators will be checked off a list with the performer's name with our Boosters at the table. The Stadium will open to spectators at 6:30 pm. Spectators must wear a mask the entire time they are on school grounds (masks must fully cover the mouth AND nose). Each small group of 4 people can sit near each other, with groups being spaced out six feet or more from other small groups. Spectators not adhering to these guidelines will be removed from school grounds by security.
- **ON THE SPOT RECORDING will be professionally recording the entire concert.** Audio Recordings will be available for purchase from this amazing company before, during, and after the concert.
- There will be a **FIREWORKS DISPLAY** towards the end of the Concert.
- **Concert Clothing:** Long-sleeved Dress Shirt (any color) AND Tie (any color) with Dress Pants (dark colors preferred); OR nice Dress with sleeves that covers the knees while seated (any colors) OR nice blouse with sleeves (any colors) with Dress Pants or Skirt that covers the knees while seated (any colors). For all outfit choices – Dress Shoes must be worn (no tennis shoes or flip flops)
 - **Clothes NOT permitted:** Short-sleeved dress shirt or polo shirt; short or revealing skirts/dresses; Sleeveless dresses or tops; Spaghetti Straps; T-shirts; jeans; leggings; shorts; casual shoes like tennis shoes or flip flops. No clothes should have words on them.

Schedule (all events located in Football Stadium):

- **During 6th/7th hour:** in-person students will assist in moving chairs/stands/equipment to the Stadium and start setting up
- **2:30 pm:** Band Council and parent volunteers arrive to Stadium to continue set-up
- **4:20 pm:** Dinner Break (pizza provided in Stadium for volunteers)
- **4:45 pm: CALL TIME for JAZZ BAND/STEEL BAND/PERCUSSION ENSEMBLES**
- **5:00 pm:** DRESS REHEARSAL in Stadium for JAZZ BAND and STEEL BAND
- **5:30 pm:** DRESS REHEARSAL for Percussion Ensembles
- **5:25 pm: CALL TIME for ALL CONCERT BANDS** (arrive prior to this to line up your cases under the stands); proceed to assigned seating on chart on the track
- **5:50 pm:** DRESS REHEARSAL for combined Concert Bands
- **6 pm:** Spectators can start lining up outside the stadium at this time.
- **6:30 pm:** Rehearsal ends; **Stadium opens to spectators;** Water/Bathroom Break (be back in assigned seats by 6:50 pm)
- **7:00 pm:** Concert Starts
 - **Jazz Bands** (1-Song for San Miguel, 2-Satin Doll, 3-Take the A Train)
 - **Steel Band** (1-Tequila, 2-Only Human, 3-Everybody Wants To Rule The World, 4-Jabba Juice)
 - **Percussion Ensembles** (1-What I've Done, 2-Fireworks, 3-Ant Man Theme)
 - **Concert Bands** (1-Alma Mater, 2-Farandole, 3-City of Lights)
 - **Combined Bands & Percussion Ensembles** (Above and Below Part 1 and 4, Fight Song)
- **Approx. 8:30 pm:** Concert ends, every student helps to load chair and stand racks, pack up instruments. Band Council and Parent Volunteers will assist for about 45 minutes after the concert to move chairs, stands, steel drums, and percussion equipment back to the Band Room/Percussion Room.
